

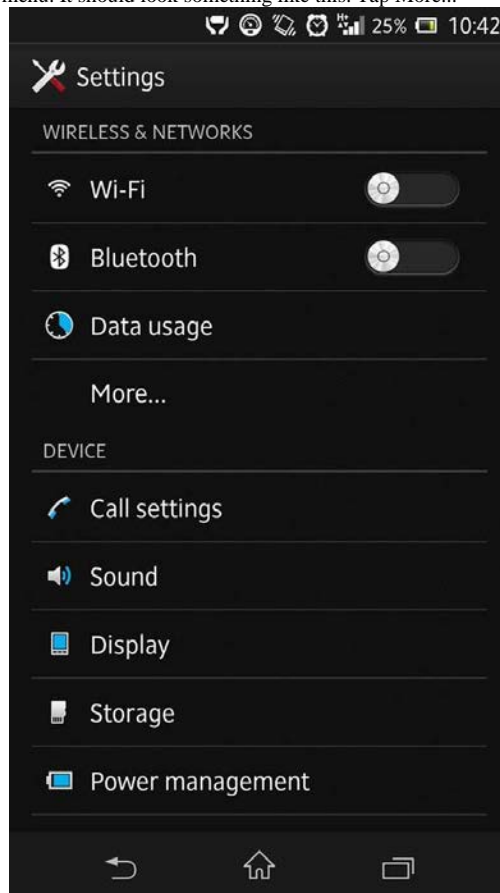


How to use a Google Android phone as a Wi-Fi hotspot

Connect to the internet when you're on the go by using your Android smartphone as a Wi-Fi hotspot. Learn how in our step-by-step guide.

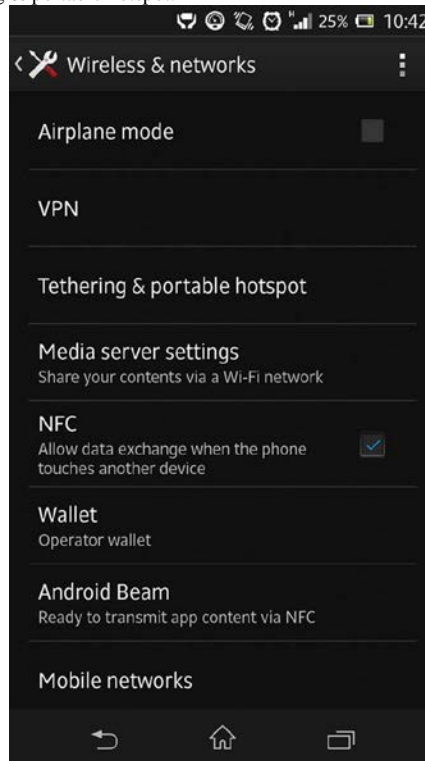
Step one

From the Home Screen, select the Settings menu. It should look something like this. Tap More...



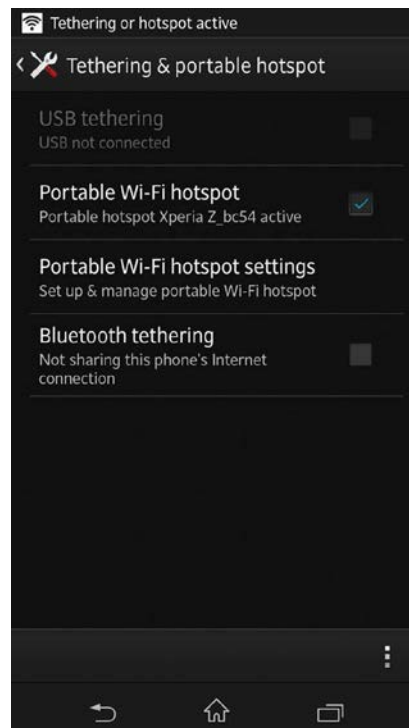
Step two

Select Wireless & Networks and then Tethering & portable hotspot.



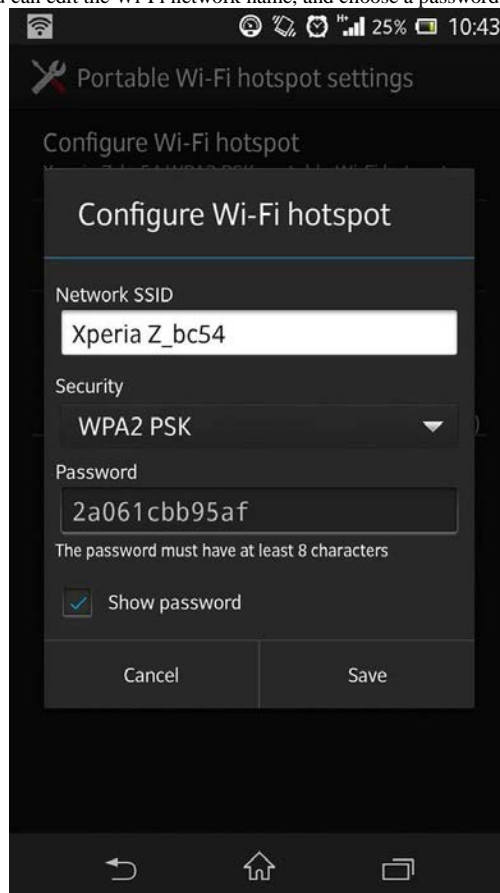
Step three

Tick the box next to Portable Wi-Fi hotspot.



Step four

Tap Portable Wi-Fi hotspot settings and you can edit the Wi-Fi network name, and choose a password.



Now on your PC or laptop, select your handset's network from the list of Wi-Fi connections available

Step five

Click connect and then you'll need to enter the password for the Wi-Fi hotspot. Once connected, you'll be able to surf the web using the handset's

3G or 4G connection to your heart's content.
